As you will be aware, your son/daughter is studying *Macbeth* for GCSE English Literature. There is a production at the Wales Millennium Centre in Cardiff in the New Year and I would like to offer your son/daughter the opportunity to attend. I propose to buy tickets for the matinee performance on the Thursday 21st March 2019, which begins at 2:30pm. While this may seem a long way off, I would like to secure tickets as soon as possible. While seeing this performance is not an essential requirement of their course, I do hope that it will be an entertaining and enriching experience with the added benefit that it may help them remember the novel for their exams!

If you would like your son/daughter to participate in this trip please log on to your parent pay account and pay **£33.00** for the trip by **Thursday 8th November 2018**. We must have payment by this date to enable us to secure tickets. Once we have sufficient numbers to run the trip tickets will be secured, therefore the only refunds available are for medical claims which require a doctor's letter. If your son/daughter is eligible for Free School Meals or if you are on Income Support, Income Based Job Seekers Allowance, Income-related Employment and Support Allowance, Universal or Child Tax Credit and are unable to meet the whole cost, please contact the finance office. **Places are limited to 65 and once these spaces have been allocated you will not be able to add your son/daughter to the trip. Parent Pay automatically reduces spaces on student allocations.** In the notes section please add any medical condition or medication taken and an emergency contact number for this trip.

If your son/daughter will need any medication on the visit, please make sure they have this with them in a labelled bag with dosage and give to their group leader on arrival at school.

Students will travel by coach leaving at 12pm and returning approximately 7pm. Please arrange to pick your child up from school. Students will need to bring a packed lunch and water (no fizzy drinks) to be eaten on the coach to Cardiff. Students are required to wear school Uniform.

Students must ensure any missed work is caught up or speak to their teachers to provide them with the necessary work beforehand.
