

Once we have sufficient numbers to run the trip tickets will be secured, therefore the only refunds available are for medical claims which require a doctor's letter. If your son/daughter is eligible for Free School Meals or if you are on Income Support, Income Based Job Seekers Allowance, Income-related Employment and Support Allowance, Universal or Child Tax Credit and are unable to meet the whole cost, please contact the finance office. **Places are limited to 62 and once these spaces have been allocated you will not be able to add your son/daughter to the trip. Parent Pay automatically reduces spaces on student allocations.** In the notes section please add any medical condition or medication taken and an emergency contact number for this trip.

If your son/daughter will need any medication on the visit, please make sure they have this with them in a labelled bag with dosage and give to their group leader on arrival at school.
