Thorpe Park Saturday 11th May 2019

On Saturday 11th May 2019, we are running a trip to Thorpe Park. Due to our group discounts this trip is excellent value at £46.50. We will travel by coach and students will be collected from and dropped off at Kingsmead School. We will depart school at 7.00am and will return by approximately 8.00pm. In order to ensure we leave Thorpe Park on time, it is vital that no one is late. If anyone misses the coach a member of staff will remain at the park. Parents/Guardian will be responsible for public transport costs back to Wiveliscombe which will be approximately £200.

Students will be allocated a place on a specified bus and must not swap coaches. They should take suitable clothing for all types of weather, they do not need to wear school uniform. We will stop at a motorway services once on each journey. Food and drinks can be taken into the park but there are many food outlets selling a wide range of food and finally staff will not be responsible for money or valuables. Students may need money for food/souvenirs but this is up to you to decide and their own responsibility.

During their time in the park, students will be free to go where they choose, however, staff will always be available at a pre-determined point in the park and contactable by mobile phone.

Places are strictly limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. We will only take FULL coaches. If you would like your son/daughter to participate in this trip please log on to your parent pay account and pay £46.50 for the trip by **Friday 1st February 2019**. We must have payment by this date to purchase the tickets at Thorpe Park. Once we have sufficient numbers to run the trip we need to make payments to our providers, therefore the only refunds available are for medical claims, which require a doctor's letter, and then processed through our school visits insurance. In the notes field on parent pay please add an emergency contact for the trip and any medical requirements.

If your son/daughter will need any medication on the visit, please make sure they have this with them in a labelled bag with dosage and give to their group leader on arrival at school.

Any excess funds raised by this trip will go towards the Zambia Exchange.

Students will be told if they have secured a place week commencing 4th February 2019.
