

## Rapid Testing in Schools Test Processors and Test Assistants

We are urgently seeking volunteers from members of our community (aged 18 or over) who would be interested in helping to support us to deliver Rapid Testing of our students at Kingsmead when they return to school from 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021. Testing will take place each school day between 08:30am and 15:00 hours and will continue for approx. 3 weeks.

The role will include:

- Supporting individuals with the collection of their self-administered swab sample
- Supporting some individuals with the administration of their swab sample
- Processing swab samples, undertaking testing in line with guidance
- Recording test results and associated administration tasks

We are seeking individuals who will:

- Be confident around but empathetic towards teenage students (from ages 11 to 16)
- Have good verbal communication skills
- Have good personal hygiene
- Undertake mundane routine tasks, maintaining attention to detail throughout
- Accept that PPE will be worn at all times, including face visors.
- Accept that confidentiality must be maintained at all times.
- Understand that although mitigation controls will be in place, there is an increased risk of exposure to Covid-19 through the number of individual contacts being made.

Government resourced training will be provided. PPE will be provided. All volunteers **will be required to undertake a prompt enhanced DBS check** in line with Keeping Children Safe in Education guidelines. Until the DBS is processed, individuals will work under supervision. A criminal record does not bar an individual from working with children in school, but the school reserves the right to withdraw employment following risk assessment.
